The EHR alert depicted below prompts outpatient clinic teams to assess for tobacco use and/or in-home exposure in the past 30 days and to place a consult order to the outpatient tobacco treatment services if any use/exposure in the past 30 days is endorsed.

Ask: Have you smoked, used tobacco products, or been exposed to second-hand smoke within your home in the past 30 days?
