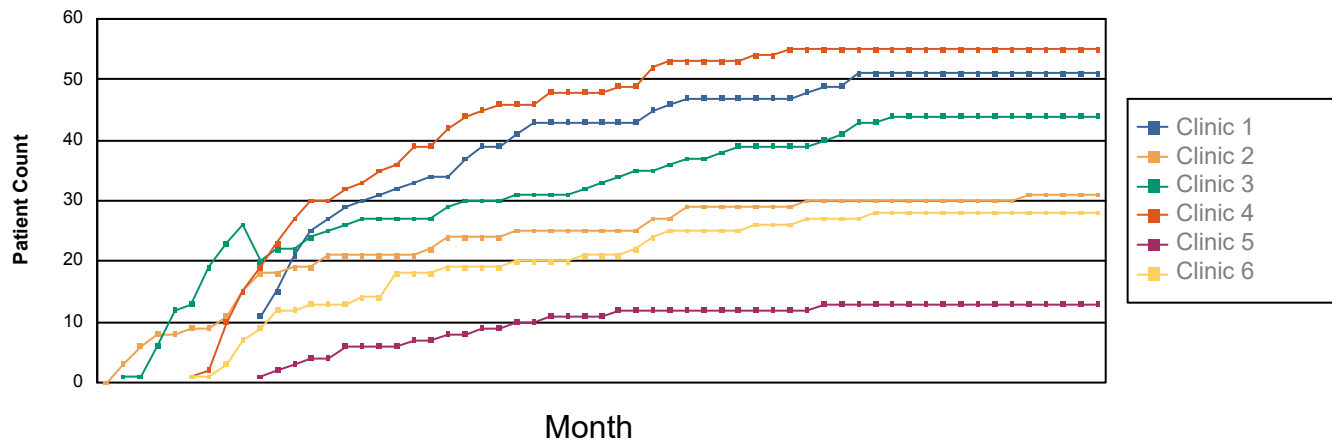

MONTHLY TREND REPORT

1. Patient must be on both Preventative and Cigarette Use Registry for at least 30 days in the time frame.
2. Patient must meet report criteria, have TTS incoming / outgoing calls, or EHR alert fired in the time frame.
3. Exclude individuals with administrative opt out or are manual overrides for the Cigarette Use Registry.
4. There were **58** patients who were willing to reduce and are excluded from this analysis.
5. Statistics were last loaded into production on 01/01/2023.

Patient Count Monthly Trend

Report no longer smoking 4-6 weeks after target quit date



Program produced additional plots displaying number of patients (by site and month) who:

- Report still smoking 4-6 weeks after target quit date
- Whose smoking status 4-6 week post-quit has not yet been assessed
- Who are engaged in a quit attempt currently (quit date is in future or past 4-6 weeks), by mechanism for treatment planning (PCP, TTS, other outreach)
- Were reached by a TTS but have not made a quit plan yet
- Received calls from a TTS but have not yet been reached
- Have received bulk outreach via mail or EHR, but not received TTS calls yet
- Have had no program activity yet
